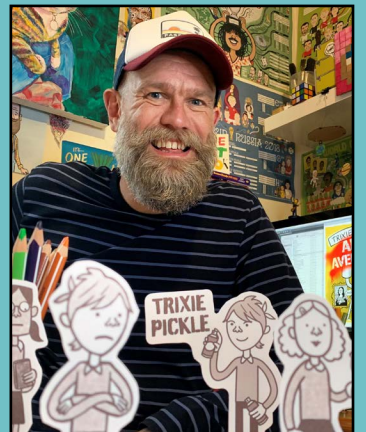

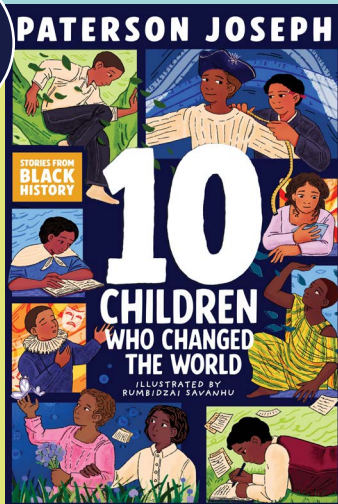
Following the success of the Livestream events last year, we are streaming again for free to students in 2026. To book your place for your school to join virtually please click on the links below.

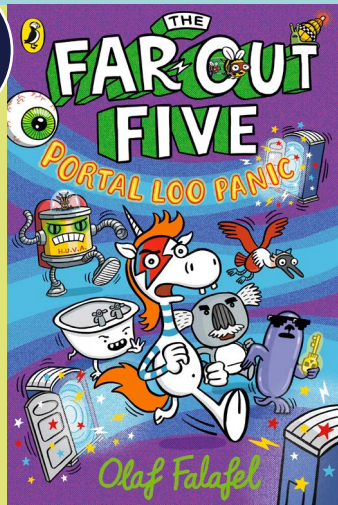

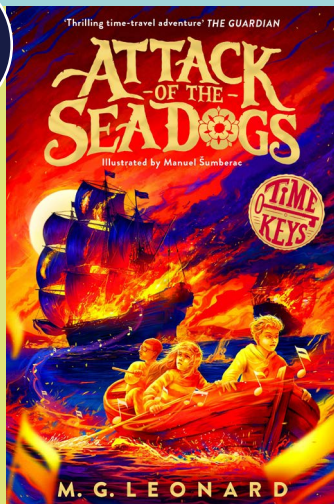

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HOW DO I BOOK MY TICKETS?

- You can book your tickets through our website (links for each event above), via this **Google Form** or by returning the booking form on p8. Your tickets will be emailed to you 10 days before the festival opens.
- Tickets will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis.
- Links to view the livestream of an event (free of charge) will be sent to you at least two days before the event.
- All events last 45 minutes.

HOW CAN I GET A COPY OF THE AUTHOR'S BOOK?

- If you are coming to the event in person, all tickets include a copy of the book which will be handed to teachers on arrival.
- If you are tuning in online a flyer will be sent out to you in September, to send out to pupils' parents and carers, explaining which books the author will be talking about. If your school is near Henley, our partner bookseller, The Bell Bookshop, will sell the authors' books at RRP in the run up and after the event.

HOW MANY PUPILS CAN I BRING ALONG TO THE FESTIVAL?

- We would love to welcome as many pupils from your school as possible to the festival. Please note the recommended ages for events before booking.
- If you are watching the livestream, make sure as many pupils are watching as possible! We would love to know the maximum number you expect to be watching so we can let the authors know how big their audience is!
- We offer discounts for pupil premium students. Please email info@henleyliteraryfestival.co.uk for more details.

HOW DO I WATCH THE EVENTS ONLINE?

- These events are Livestreamed directly from our venues to Crowdcast (our streaming platform) and you will receive an email prior to the event with full details. Details on how to watch will be sent to you at least two days before the event.
